Discussion Questions for 14 June 2020

- Define assurance.
 - Do you think that most Christians like to admit when they are struggling with assurance? Why or why not?
 - Have you ever struggled with assurance during your life? Share your experience.
 - Why do you think that Christians sometimes struggle with assurance? Discuss some possible reasons.
- Hebrews 6 introduced the idea of a promise and an oath. Can you think of some examples of when people might take an oath?
 - What is the purpose of an oath? Why do people take an oath?
 - What do you think it means that God took an oath in Hebrews 6:13, 17? Why did God take this oath (v18)?
 - How do God's promise and oath help grow assurance? Discuss.
- Re-read John 6:35-40. Based on these verses, can someone who truly believes in Jesus be eternally lost (go to hell)? Explain.
 - How can a holy God completely forgive sinners like us?
- According to Romans 8:15-17, how does the Holy Spirit witness to us?
 - Can you think of a time when you instinctively cried out to your Heavenly Father in prayer? Share your experience.
- We saw that assurance grows when we focus on God and not just on ourselves. What are some practical ways we can remind ourselves of God's work for us this week?
