 - Are babies really born sinful? Discuss.
 - Why is it important to realize that everyone has a problem with sin? What difference does this make for us?
 - Who is one non-Christian you can be praying for?
- Using vv10-18 as a guide, list some specific ways we sin.
 - Can non-Christians do outwardly good things? Discuss.
 - How can outwardly good actions be corrupted by sin? Give some examples.
- What does our sin deserve (vv19-20)? Why?
- What does God give us in Jesus Christ? Briefly explain vv21-26 in your own words.
 - How do we receive this free gift? Discuss.
 - As Christians, is sin still a problem for us? Is there hope for us to battle sin? Explain.
- What is one sin that you need to address?
 - In dependence on God, what are some practical steps you might take to address this sin? Share some ideas.
